He began his music studies at Casa de la Cultura de San Fernando at the end of 2009, with Professor Arturo Bustos and later with Professor Matías Otárola.

In 2015, he entered the Conservatory of Universidad Mayor. He continued his training at the Faculty of Arts of Universidad de Chile, with Maestro Edward Brown.

He has won the scholarship to join the FOJI National Youth Symphony Orchestra, and has participated in festivals and an international tour to Morocco, Spain and Germany. In addition, he received the FOJI "Teacher Training" scholarship for further training as a French horn teacher.

He has played in the Chamber Orchestra of Chile, the Philharmonic Orchestra of Temuco, the Classical Orchestra of Maule, the Symphonic Orchestra of Universidad de La Serena, the Philharmonic Orchestra of Teatro Municipal de Santiago, the USACH Classical Orchestra, and the Camareta U. Andes, among others.

He is currently a brass instructor at the O'Higgins Regional Orchestra of the FOJI, horn teacher since 2018 at the Casa de la Cultura de Rancagua, and part of Quinteto Ventum.
