**Flute**

Born in Montevideo in 2001, she began her musical studies at the age of 8 at the "Virgilio Scarabelli Alberti" Music School, studying recorder. In 2014 she entered the Municipal School of Music "Vicente Ascone" to begin her training in transverse flute under the guidance of Prof. Carlos Alberte, graduating in 2021 with a special mention from the jury.

She is currently flutist and piccolo player of the Montevideo Philharmonic Orchestra and member of the Sodre Youth Orchestra since 2018, occupying the position of principal flute from the year 2021.

He has taken master classes with teachers such as Curt Schroeter (Brazil), Horacio Parraviccini (Argentina), Renata Xavier (Brazil), among others. In 2020 she participated in the meeting of the Music Festival of Santa Catarina, Brazil (FEMUSC). She is the winner of the competition "Young Soloists" of the Orquesta Juvenil del Sodre in its 2022 edition.

She is currently studying at the Escuela Universitaria de Música, in the second semester of the degree in musical interpretation, in traverse flute, under the guidance of Prof. Pablo Somma, and also takes monthly classes with Mtro Jorge de la Vega in Buenos Aires, Argentina.
