In 2019 she received her degree as a performer in cello at Conservatorio de Música del Estado de México and began her professional studies at the same institution, finishing them in August 2023.

In 2022 she completed a diploma course with the OAcademy, which together with the Orchestra of the Americas selects the best young musicians from all over the Americas for a six-month training course, providing the necessary tools to perform adequately in a working orchestral environment.

She was also a member of Sinfónica Azteca, a project that seeks to provide the necessary tools to improve education and expand the professional international music sector for young Mexicans, being the only one selected to represent the State of Mexico.

She participated in masterclasses with internationally renowned cellists such as Steven Isserlis, Paul Katz, Jennifer Culp, Sam MaGill, Rachel Mercer, Raman Ramakrishnan, Christine Lamprea, Michal Shein, among others. She has also received advice on orchestral passages from conductors such as Alexander Shelley and Elena Schwarz, among others.

Also in 2022, she was the winner of the first contest "Young musicians from Mexico and the musical community of the State of Mexico", and participated in the "Cellisimo Festival 2022", as well as completing a certificate in preparation for auditions by "CelloBello", taught by teachers from the great international music schools.

In April 2023 she participated in the Guadalajara International Music Festival, having the opportunity to take lessons with maestros Giovanni Gnocchi and Andrew Mark, and in June of the same year she was the winner of the "Laszlo Frater" 2023 competition organized by Conservatorio de Música del Estado de México.
