He began his studies at the Juan José Castro Conservatory with Raúl del Castillo. He was a member of the Orquesta Sinfónica Juvenil Nacional "José de San Martín" between 2012 and 2021, taking orchestral repertoire classes with María Cecilia Muñoz. He has performed on several occasions as a soloist in the National Auditorium of the Kirchner Cultural Centre and in the Aula Magna of the Faculty of Law under the baton of Mario Benzecry and César Iván Lara.

He has also performed as a soloist at the National Library, Manzana de las Luces, Bolsa de Comercio de Buenos Aires and at the Howard Johnson Hotel, with the Encuentro Orchestra and the Orquesta Sinfónica Joven, conducted by Mauricio Weintraub and Roberto Luvini.

In 2018 he entered the Instituto Superior de Arte del Teatro Colón, to improve his skills with Claudio Barile and Jorge de la Vega. She is currently taking private flute lessons with Amalia Pérez.

She has participated in masterclasses with Felix Renggli, James Lyman, Michel Bellavance, Horacio Parravicini, Rachel Brown, Toon Fret, Trudy Kane, Dóra Ombodi and Luis Rossi.

Since 2018 he has been a member of the quintet Blansarme, with whom he has recorded the album "Premiados 4", and with whom he won the First Prize at the National Chamber Music Competition of Rosario.

In 2020 he was selected with the Blansarme quintet to participate in the Portillo International Chamber Music Festival in Chile, taking classes with teachers from all over America. He was also part of the festival's orchestra, giving concerts in Santiago and Rancagua under the baton of Alejandra Urrutia.
