At the age of 10 he began his studies as a violinist within the Sistema de Orquestas Juveniles

Orchestras of Venezuela. He has participated as guest violinist in the 4th Annual International Youth Symphony in California, USA and in the Orquesta Juvenil del Bicentenario as leader in Mexico and Argentina. Between 2012 and 2018 he served as violinist of the Simón Bolívar Symphony Orchestra of Venezuela, with which he toured extensively in Latin America, Asia and Europe. He is co-founder of the Yaracuy String Quartet, with which he performed numerous concerts and festivals such as the premiere of 4 Latin American works commissioned by Carnegie Hall in New York; and a concert at the Esterházy String Quartet Festival in the city of Eisenstadt, Vienna. In 2019 he migrates to Chile. Country where he has participated as a guest with various groups such as Tango Ensembles, Salsa Orchestras and Jazz Ensembles.

Currently he is a violinist of the Chamber Orchestra of the Friends of the Municipal Theatre, the Chamber Orchestra of the Andrés Bello University and the Artes Quartet; quartet with which he has participated in the Portillo Chamber Music Festival 2020 edition; in 2021 they premiered all the works participating in the composition camps broadcast by CNN Chile and toured 4 cities in southern Chile representing the Municipal Theatre. In February 2022 they participated in the Festival Internacional de Música de la Patagonia where they saw classes and played with the Cuarteto Latinoamericano.
