

## **Roger Campos**

### **Violin**

Roger was born in Santa Ana de Coro (Venezuela) on 29 July 1997. He started playing the violin at the age of 7 at the Conservatory of Music "Santa Ana de Coro" in his hometown. There he began to grow as a musician in the National System of Orchestras of Venezuela "El Sistema". In this city, he began to play in youth orchestras, performing a wide variety of orchestral music, and also began to give violin lessons at the conservatory.

At the age of 17, he moved to Mérida, where he began studying music at the Universidad de Los Andes. In this city he won through an audition the position of Assistant Violinist in the Orquesta Sinfónica del Estado Mérida. In this orchestra he began to make his professional life, playing high-level orchestral repertoire and performing as a soloist on two occasions. He also started giving violin lessons at "El Sistema" in Mérida.

In 2017, Roger moved to Mendoza - Argentina, where he continued studying music at the National University of Cuyo. He has also been able to perform in numerous festivals with chamber music, and orchestral performances with the Orquesta Filarmónica de Mendoza and the Orquesta Sinfónica de la Universidad Nacional de Cuyo.

He is currently in his final year at university. He works as a violin-viola teacher in a School Orchestra and also as a substitute violinist in the Orquesta in the Philharmonic Orchestra of Mendoza and the Symphonic Orchestra of the National University of Cuyo.
