Violin

Born on 14 April 1998 in the State of Mexico, at the age of 8 he began to play Mexican popular music under the tutelage of Victoria Garduño. Later he enters the National Conservatory of Music, where to date he studies with violin master Bagrat Abadjian, whose professorship has led him to participate in the Inter-institutional Violin Encounter on 3 occasions. During his academic career he has actively participated in the Symphonic Orchestra of the National Conservatory of Music, in which he held the position of concertmaster and with which he has participated as soloist in venues such as the Vasconcelos Library, the Alcazar de Chapultepec and the Silvestre Revueltas Auditorium.

He has also ventured into contemporary music through the Ensamble de Música Contemporánea del CNM, and has even collaborated with the ensemble CEPROMUSIC under the direction of José Luis Castillo and Germán Tort Ortega. On the other hand, he was part of the ensemble Lux Antiqua focused on the performance of early music.

Oswaldo dedicates his summers to chamber music, and has participated in national festivals in Tequila, Naolinco, Xalapa and Guadalajara, where he has given recitals with chamber ensembles, from trios to string sextets. In Guadalajara he participated in the FORMANDI festival, where he had the opportunity to take classes with great violinists such as Claude Richard and Victor Fournelle, and was a finalist in the competition organised by the festival. He also participated in the Strings in Motion course, where he collaborated in chamber ensembles with musicians from the Mozrteum University, Salzburg, and received master classes from the renowned music pedagogue Christos Kanettis.

In 2019 Oswaldo collaborated as concertmaster with the YOLA (Youth Orchestra of Los Angeles) at the Palacio de Bellas Artes and at the Complejo Cultural Los Pinos under the direction of maestro Paolo Bortolameolli and the renowned maestro Gustavo Dudamel. In 2020 he joined the Orquesta Filarmónica Mexiquense as concertmaster and is currently a member of this orchestra.
