She began her violin studies at the age of 10 at the Santa Marta Institute in Curicó in 2011 with Claudio Muñoz as her teacher. At the same time, she joined the children's and youth orchestra of that institution, where she was concertmaster. Later, in 2014, she was selected to be part of the Orquesta Sinfónica Juvenil Regional del Maule de la Fundación de Orquestas Juveniles e Infantiles de Chile (FOJI), a group to which she still belongs today. In the same year he took part in the regional violin performance competition organised by the music school of the University of Talca, where he won 2nd place in the under-18 category. Then, in 2017 he was awarded the "Orchestral Merit Scholarship" for having obtained the highest qualification at regional level to belong to the OSJRMaule in that year. Subsequently, in 2019, he entered the Bachelor's Degree in Performance and Specialised Music Education, mention in violin and orchestral conducting, in which he had as professors violinists Ana Liz Ojeda (2019) and Dorian Lamotte (2020-2022). In addition, this year, it has participated in the festival "Orquesta del Encuentro 2022" in Los Angeles, California, USA, under the baton of the Venezuelan conductor Gustavo D'Escoto.
