I am a 22 year old violinist from the city of Puerto Varas. My taste for music was born at school when I listened to the first children's orchestra. I began my formal studies of violin and music theory at the Municipal Music Academy of Puerto Varas, under the tutelage of Professor Carlos Toledo, in 2012. There I began my participation in the Academy's musical workshop and in 2013 as a violinist in the Puerto Varas Philharmonic Orchestra, participating in various regional and interregional tours. In 2015 I began my stay in the Puerto Varas Chamber Orchestra, which included national tours to Santiago, participation as an active orchestra in the Liliana Perez Corey Competition, joint performances with the UFRO choir, and international tours to Argentina with the polyphonic choir of Bariloche; in several concerts I participated as concertmaster and soloist.

In 2018 I started my professional studies at the Universidad Austral de Chile, in the professorship of the chair of Professor Juan Carlos Soto.

In my career as a violinist, I have participated in several festivals, among which the most important ones are the International Music Festival of Patagonia 2019 and 2020, Saint John String Quartet Meeting 2019, Chamber Music Festival Valdivia 2020, Violin Week La Serena 2020 and International Music Festival of Huilo Huilo 2021 and 2022; and masterclasses with outstanding violinists such as Matias Krug, Emiliane Takeshi, Alessandro Borgomanero, Krzysztof Lason, David Adams, Daniele Sanette, Catalina Barraza, Emmanuele Baldini, Dorian Lamote, Otto Derolez, Mari Hagiwara.
