Viridiana began her musical studies at the Conservatorio Nacional de Música and at the Conservatorio de las Rosas (Mexico) under the tutelage of Mtra. Gellya Dubrova and later under the tutelage of Mtro. Julián Martínez Vázquez, with whom she concluded her musical studies.

Selected in different international music festivals: Young Euro Classic (Germany, 2016), Festival Internacional de Música de Esmeraldas (Ecuador, 2019) and Festival Internacional de Música Portillo (Chile, 2020), Festival Sinfonietta (2021), Orquesta Nacional Azteca (2021).

In 2021 she was selected to join the Orchestra of the Americas/OAcademy completing the programme "Orchestral Performance and Digital Creation", under the violin professorship of Nikki Chooi.

Viridiana has received different master classes by distinguished musicians, including Elena Urioste, Nikki Chooi, Timothy Chooi, Kay Stern, Jonathan Crow, Marco Fusi, Cho-Liang Lin, Lynn Chang, Michael Foyle, American String Quartet, Francisco Vila, Sonar Quartet, Wiener Kammer-symphonie, Sarita Wong, Cracow Duo, among others. In September 2021 he began his master's studies at the Longy School of Music of Bard College, in Massachusetts, USA, under the professorship of Dr. Sean Wang. Since her stay in Boston, Viridiana is part of the Eureka Ensemble and the DuBois Orchestra at Harvard, with whom she plays in their regular seasons and concerts.
