In 2012 he graduated from the pre-university level with the title of "Musical Interpreter in Traverse Flute". In 2020 he graduated from "Profesorado Universitario en Música: Flauta" under the guidance of Maestro Renato Ligutti, obtaining the gold medal for the best average awarded by the Faculty of Philosophy, Humanities and Arts of the National University of San Juan. From an early age he has participated in numerous chamber groups, youth orchestras and ensembles. He attended numerous tours with the Orquesta Sinfónica Nacional y Juvenil del Bicentenario, performing concerts in large halls of the country.

Since 2012 he has held the position of Flute soloist in the Camerata San Juan.

He has actively participated in several Master Classes given by important Flute Masters such as Felix Renggli (Switzerland), Patrick Gallois (France), Michel Bellavance (Canada - Switzerland), among others.

Thanks to the support of scholarships granted on several occasions by the Mozarteum Argentino, the Fondo Nacional de las Artes and the Fundación Banco San Juan, she was able to take advanced classes in the city of Buenos Aires with Professor María Cecilia Muñoz, current substitute soloist of the Orquesta Estable de Teatro Colón.

In August 2016 she actively participated in the SOMMERAKADEMIE 2016 of the Mozarteum Universität in the city of Salzburg, Austria, taking classes with the renowned Maestro Peter-Lukas Graf.

In the year 2021 he obtained a place in the flute section of the UNSJ Symphony Orchestra.
